### Preamble:

The electronics sector is recognized globally as a catalyst for digital transformation and industrial competitiveness. In view of its cross-sectoral applications, electronics manufacturing plays a strategic role in realizing the vision of a digitally empowered and self-reliant economy.

In alignment with the Government of India's vision to strengthen the domestic electronics manufacturing ecosystem under the Electronics Component Manufacturing Scheme (ECMS), the Government of Odisha is committed to complementing these efforts by fostering a robust component manufacturing base within the State. Recognizing the Electronics System Design and Manufacturing (ESDM) sector as a Thrust Sector under the Odisha Industrial Policy Resolution (IPR), Odisha is strategically positioning itself as a preferred destination for investments across the electronics value chain—especially in critical and high-value sub-segments.

### Resolution:

The Government of Odisha hereby notifies the Odisha Electronics Component Manufacturing Policy – 2025, which aims to extend complementary incentives to units approved under the ECMS scheme of Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), Government of India (GoI). The State shall provide matching and additional support to accelerate investment in electronics component manufacturing.

## 1. Definition:

The definitions provided under the Electronics Component Manufacturing Scheme (ECMS), Government of India Gazette Notification No. CG-DL-E-08042025-262341 dated 08/04/2025, and subsequent Guidelines dated 26/04/2025 shall be adopted for the implementation of this policy.

## 2. Eligibility:

Eligible units must:

- I. Have obtained approval under ECMS from the Competent Authority of MeitY, Gol.
- II. Propose to establish the approved manufacturing facility within Odisha.

## 3. Incentives:

Units fulfilling the eligibility criteria shall receive incentives from Govt. of India in accordance with Annexure A (2) of the ECMS Guidelines, subject to meeting the quantification criteria under the scheme and the threshold Criteria under Annexure A (3) of ECMS.

### 3.1. State Incentives:

Units qualifying under ECMS can opt for any ONE of the following options for availing the incentives:

(a). Option 1: **Early Applicants: The first ten (10) projects**

- i. Five (5) projects with a minimum investment of ₹ 50 crore
- ii. At least Five (5) projects with a minimum investment of ₹ 200 crores.

Over the period of five (5) years shall be eligible for a capital subsidy covering 50% of their eligible investment. This subsidy will be disbursed in two (2) equal annual instalments.

(b). Option 2: **Matching Subsidy:**

In addition to the incentives extended under the Electronics Component Manufacturing Scheme (ECMS) of the Government of India, the Government of Odisha shall provide matching support equivalent to the central incentive, supplemented by an additional 1% TLI and an extra 10% capital expenditure incentive over and above the matching support (as illustrated in Table 1 below)

The incentives shall be disbursed in proportion to the disbursement made by MEITY, subject to timely submission of documents and eligibility confirmation by the Nodal Agency.

## Provisional Incentives:

If, in any given year, the unit achieves at least 50% of each of the three targets—turnover, investment, and employment—then, irrespective of the subsidy released by the Government of India (GoI), the Government of Odisha (GoO) will provide a subsidy in accordance with the percentages specified for that year in the ECMS as notified by the GoI. This subsidy will be disbursed in two equal annual instalments.

### 3.2. Land /Rental Support

- Land: Eligible units shall be allotted land by Odisha Industrial Infrastructure Development Corporation (IDCO), on recommendation of OCAC, as per extant Odisha Electronics Policy  
  
OR
- Rental Assistance: Units operating from infra/flatted factory developed by IDCO or other infrastructure including state-approved industrial infrastructure, shall be eligible for rental reimbursement as per extant Odisha Electronics Policy

### 3.3. Power Tariff and Electricity Duty:

Eligible Units shall be entitled to avail Industrial Power Tariff and Electricity Duty exemption as per IPR 2022 and subsequent amendments.

- Eligible Units shall be provided 100% exemption from payment of Electricity Duty for a period of 10 years from the date of commencement of commercial production.
- Eligible Units shall be provided reimbursement of Power Tariff of Rs. 2.00 per unit consumed and purchased from local DISCOMs for a period of 10 years from the date of commencement of commercial production.

### 3.4 Other incentives:

**a.** Eligible units under this policy (excluding category “D” Supply Chain ecosystem and Capital equipment of Electronics Component Manufacturing Scheme, MeitY, GoI) shall be eligible to avail incentives available under extant Odisha Electronics Policy pertaining to Land rate(including Stamp duty and Conversion charges), Human Capital(Recruitment Assistance, Training Assistance), Reimbursement of Tax (SGST) paid, Assistance to Women Entrepreneurs and Persons with Disabilities, Assistance to R&D Units and Assistance for Technical Know-how.

**b.** Eligible units under category “D” Supply Chain ecosystem and Capital equipment Electronics Component Manufacturing Scheme, MeitY, GoI, shall be eligible to avail all other incentives available under IPR 2022 and subsequent amendments.

**3.5.** The total incentives provided by the Government of Odisha to any firm will be capped at a maximum of 75% of the firm’s investment made within the state.

### 3.6. Special Incentives and Concessions for Mega Projects

- a. Projects with a proposed investment exceeding INR 500 Crores, or those generating a minimum of 1,000 employment opportunities within a committed investment period of 5 years, will be classified as Mega Projects.
- b. Such Mega Projects will be eligible for customized incentives and concessions designed to support their scale and impact.

### 4. Period of the policy:

Period of the policy will be co-terminus with the implementation period of the ECMS Scheme of MeitY, Gol.

### 5. Nodal Agency:

The Odisha Computer Application Centre (OCAC) under the Electronics and IT Department shall function as the Nodal Agency for implementation of this Policy.

### 6. Investment Facilitation Mechanism:

There shall be a 3-tier Single Window Clearance Authority (SWCA) for clearance of ESDM projects as enumerated below

- a. Investments up to INR 50 crore - Special Single window Clearance Committee (SSWCC) under the chairmanship of Secretary, Electronics & IT, Govt. of Odisha.
- b. Investments above INR 50 crore and up to INR1000 crore - State Level Single Window Clearance Authority (SLSWCA) members as constituted under the Odisha Industries Facilitation Act, (OIFA) 2004, under the chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Govt. of Odisha.
- c. Investment above INR 1,000 crore - High Level Clearance Authority (HLCA) headed by the Chief Minister with members as constituted under the Odisha Industries Facilitation Act, (OIFA) 2004.

Odisha Computer Application Centre (OCAC) will provide secretarial assistance to the SSWCC.

The SSWCC or SLSWCA shall carry out the following functions:

- i. Issue approvals of projects as required under the appropriate rules as and when necessary.
- ii. Issue deemed approvals as provided in OIFA as and when necessary.
- iii. Review and monitor the processing of applications cleared earlier and sent to Competent Authorities

SSWCC shall approve this disbursement of incentives for all projects approved under the Single Window mechanism

## **7. Disbursal Mechanism:**

The incentives outlined in this policy will be provided to eligible companies in accordance with the operational guidelines, which will be notified separately. Units are required to submit a copy of the documents submitted to MeitY concurrently to the Electronics and IT Department, Government of Odisha (E&IT Dept., GoO). The E&IT Dept., GoO will undertake the necessary actions to implement the operational guidelines for this policy.

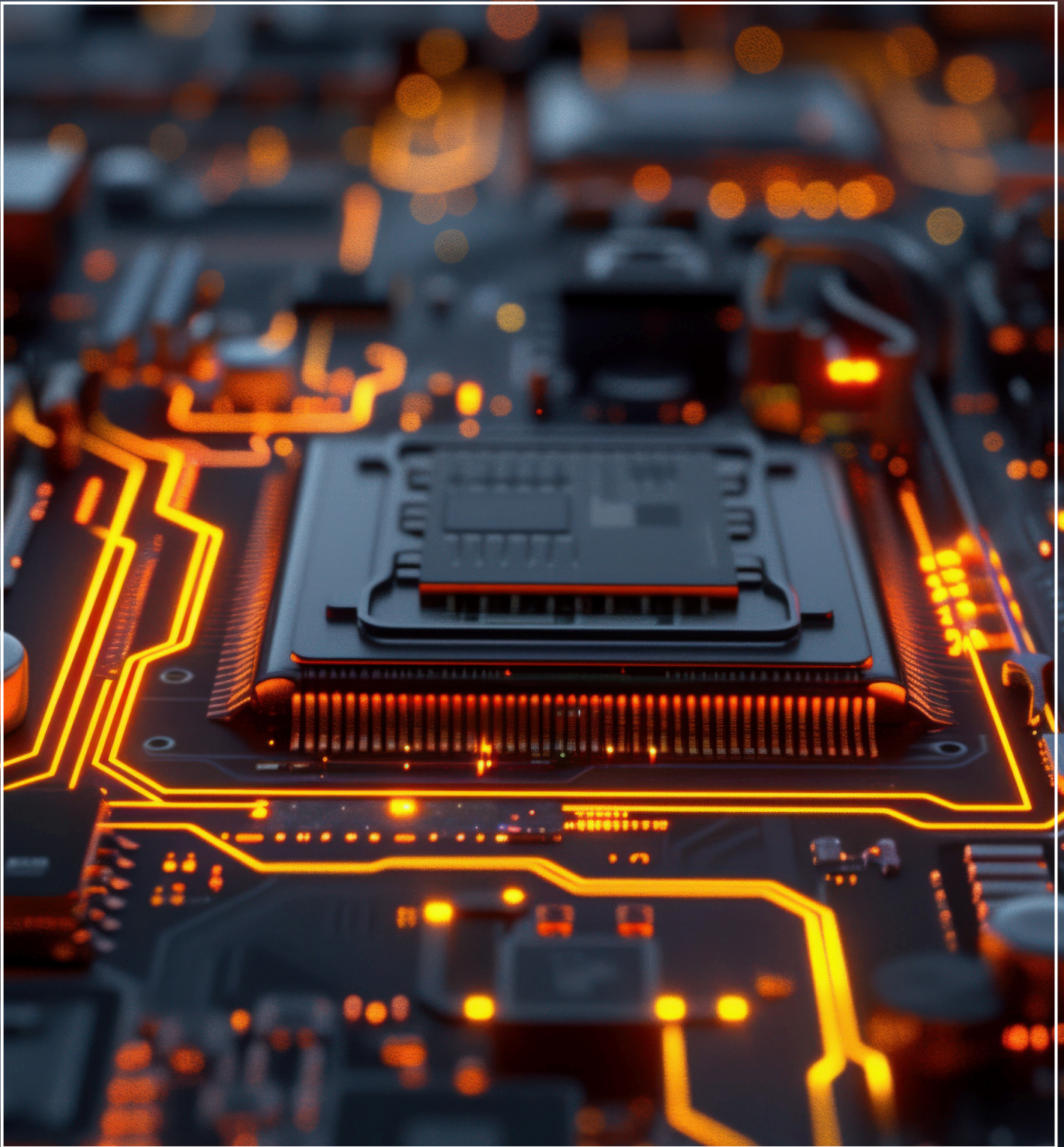
## **8. Interpretation:**
