Engagement of retired Secondary School teachers on "Teacher on Call Scheme"

Please refer to this Department letter No-16311/SME dtd.09.09.2010 in which instruction was issued for introduction of "Retired Teachers on call Scheme" in the State to over come the situation arising out of shortage of Teachers in Govt. High Schools in the State. Accordingly, a good number of retired teachers have been engaged with the approval of the Collectors of concerned districts.

Govt. after careful consideration have been pleased to decide that the retired teachers engaged in High Schools in accordance with the terms and conditions stipulated in the letter referred to above shall be paid honorarium @ of Rs.150/- per class subject to maximum of Rs.2400/- per month.

This dispensation would be available till March, 2011.

The Head Master / Head Mistress of the concerned schools shall intimate the number of classes taken by the Teacher in a month to the concerned Inspector of Schools for drawal and disbursement of the amount.
