RESOLUTION

Sub:-Revision of Pension / Family Pension & Gratuity of Post-2006 Pensioners / Family Pensioners in case of employees of Non-Govt. Aided Primary Schools and other Non-Govt. Aided Educational Institutions under School and Mass Education Department; who are availing revised scale of pay w.e.f.01. 01.2006.

Finance Department in their Resolution No-Pen-181/08- 3653/F dtd.19.01.09 have revised the Pension/ Family Pension & Gratuity of post-1.1.2006 State Govt. Pensioners /Family pensioners .Keeping in view of such revision, State Govt. in School & Mass Education Deptt. have been pleased to revise the pension/family pension and gratuity of post 1.1.2006 retired Employees of Non-Govt. Aided primary schools & Non-Govt. Aided Educational Institutions under School and Mass Education Department w.e.f. 01.01.06 as follows.

2. Pension:-

(1) An employee of Aided Non-Govt. Educational Institution and Non-Govt. Aided Primary Schools retiring from service on or after 1.1.06 is entitled to Pension /Family Pension and Gratuity in accordance with the provisions contained in O A E I E R B –Rules, 1981 and the O A E I (Non-Govt. fully Aided Primary School Teachers') Retirement Benefit Rules, 1986 respectively and subsequent amendments there on. But in case of an employee of such category retiring before completion of the minimum qualifying service of 10 years shall not be entitled to pension but he shall continue to be entitled to service gratuity in terms of Rule-8(1) of O A E I R B Rules, 1981 and Rule 8 of OAEI (Non Govt fully aided primary school teachers') Retirement Benefit Rules, 1986 respectively.

(2) Qualifying service of **33 years** was required for sanction of full pension in terms of O A E I R B – Rule,1981 and O A E I (Non-Govt. fully Aided Primary School Teachers') Retirement Benefit Rules,1986. Now the Govt. have been pleased to decide that such categories of employees as indicated under Para -2(l) above who have retired on or after 01.12.08 and have rendered the minimum qualifying service of 25 years would now be entitled for pension at the rate of 50% of the last emolument (basic pay + grade pay) drawn by them on the date of their retirement. Rule 8(2) (a) and 8(2) (b) of the O.A.E.I.E. Retirement benefit Rules, 1981 stands modified to the above extent.

In case of employees retiring before completion of 25 years of qualifying service, but after completion of 10 years, the amount of pension shall be proportionate to the amount of full pension admissible on completion of 25 years of service.

But in no case the amount of pension shall be less than the minimum amount of pension admissible & now fixed at Rs.3,500/- per month.

(3) The revised provisions for calculation of pension in Para 2(2) above shall come into force **w.e.f. 01.12.2008**. An employee of fully Aided Non-Govt. Educational Institution and Non-Govt fully Aided Primary Schools retiring on or after 1.1.06. but before 01.12.2008 will continue to be governed by the rules /orders which were in force immediately before coming in to effect of this Resolution.

(4) The minimum amount of pension admissible shall be Rs.3, 500/- and maximum up to 50% of the last pay and grade pay drawn by the employee.

(5) The provisions contained in O A E I E R B –Rules, 1981 and O A E I (Non-Govt. fully Aided Primary School Teachers') Retirement Benefit Rules, 1986 shall stand modified to the extent in Para 2(2) and 2(4) above.

(6) Additional Pension.

The quantum of pension available to the old pensioners shall be increased as indicated in the following table **w.e.f. 01.12.2008**.

Age of Pensioners	Additional quantum of pension
From 80 years to less than 85 years	20% of the basic pension
From 85 years to less than 90 years	30% of the basic pension
From 90 years to less than 95 years	40% of the basic pension
From 95 years to less than 100 years	50% of the basic pension
100 years or more	100 % of the basic pension

The amount of additional pension will be shown distinctly in the Pension Payment Order. The other terms and conditions as indicated in Para -2(6) of the Finance Deptt. Resolution No.3653 / F dtd.19.01.2009 is the same as regards sanction of addl. Pension in respect of above categories of pensioners.

(7) In case of pensioners who are in receipt of more than one pension and if the quantum of both the pensions taken together is less than the floor ceiling of Rs. 3,500/- pm, in that case it shall be stepped up to Rs.3,500/- per month.

Age of family pensioner	Additional quantum of family pension
From 80 years to less than 85 years	20% of basic family pension
From 85 years to less than 90 years	30% of basic family pension

(3) Gratuity :-

The employees of Non-Govt. Aided Primary Schools on their retirement were entitled to Death cum Retirement Gratuity at the rates admissible to their counterpart in State Govt. service in terms of para-8 of the O.A.E.I(Non-Govt. fully Aided Primary School Teachers')Retirement Benefit Rules 1986 and para-3(8)(1) of this Department Notification No.8972/S&ME Dt.23.3.1998.Now it is decided that such category of employees on their retirement on or after 01.01.06 shall be entitled for Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity as admissible to the State Govt. employees in terms of para-3 of Finance Department Resolution No-3653 /F dt.19.01.2009 .

In case of employees of Non-Govt. Aided Educational institutions, the maximum limit of Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity was 7 ½ months pay in terms of Rule-9 of the OAEIERB Rules 1981. Now it is decided that such benefits of 7 ½ months pay including grade pay shall continue to be applicable in case of employees retiring on or after 01.12.08 consequent upon revision of their pay scales w.e.f.01.01.06. But the employees of above category who have retired during 01.01.2006 to 30.11.08 shall be entitled to DCRG in terms of above rules maximum up to the limit of Rs. 2.50 lakhs as admissible in case of State Govt. employees on revision of their pay scale w.e.f.01.01.2006.

4. Family Pension:-

The Family pension as admissible to the state Govt. family pensioners in terms of Para-5(1) and para-5(2) of the FD Resolution No-3653/F dtd.19.01.09 shall be admissible to the family pension holders of Non-Govt. Aided educational Institutions and Non-Govt. Aided Primary Schools from the date so mentioned in the said Resolution in terms of this Department Notification No-28099/SME dtd.18.10.2001 and NotificationNo-28096/SME dtd.18.10.01 respectively.

Additional Family Pension.

5. (1) In addition to the family pension calculated in para-4 above, the quantum of family pension available to the old family pensioners shall be increased as follows with effect from 01.12.2008.

Age of family pensioner	Additional quantum of family pension
From 80 years to less than 85 years	20% of basic family pension
From 85 years to less than 90 years	30% of basic family pension

From 90 years to less than 95 years	40 % of basic family pension
From 95 years to less than 100 years	50 % of basic family pension
From 100 years or more	100% of basic family pension

The amount of Additional family pension shall be shown distinctly in the pension payment order. In case of family pensioners who are in receipt of more than one pension / family pension, the floor ceiling of Rs.3500/- will apply to the total of all pensions taken together. Thus, where the consolidated pension / family pension works out to an amount less than Rs.3,500/- pm, the same shall be stepped up to Rs.3,500/- pm.

The other terms and condition as indicated in Para -6 of the FD Resolution No-3653 /F dtd.19.01.09 is the same as regards sanction of Addl. Family Pension in respect of above category of family pensioners.

6.Emoluments:-

For the purpose of calculation of pension/ family pension/ gratuity of the employees of Non-Govt. Aided Primary Schools and other Non Govt. Aided Educational Institutions under School and Mass Education Deptt., who have retired on or after 01.01.2006, the emoluments shall have the same meaning as defined in Note-1 of clause (b) of Sub-rule (2) of rule-8 of the Orissa Aided Educational Institutions Employees' Retirement Benefit Rules,1981. The emolument for the purpose should mean the revised basic pay plus grade pay effective from the 01.01.2006 under the Orissa revised Scales of Pay Rules'2008.

7. All pensioners /family pensioners shall submit an undertaking to the Pension Sanctioning Authority that where in course of fixation of pension /family pension , any amount drawn or received as basic pension/ basic family pension by the pensioners /family pensioners under any circumstances is found to be in excess of the amount payable to him or her under this Resolution, the amount so drawn or received shall be recoverable from such pensioner / family pensioner from his or her Pension and Dearness Relief as specified in the prescribed form as at Annexure -1.

8. The arrear pension/ family pension due to such revision would be paid during the financial year 2010-11

This has been concurred in by the Finance Department in their UOR No.228/CS-III m Dtd.11.10.2010.



2.1. An employee of Aided Non-Govt. Educational Institution and Non-Govt. Aided Primary Schools retiring from service on or after 1-1-06 is entitled to Pension /Family Pension and Gratuity in accordance with the provisions contained in O & A E I E R S - Rules, 1981 and the O & A E I E R S (for Govt. fully Aided Primary School Teachers) Retirement Benefit Rules, 1981 as amended by subsequent amendments there on. But in case of an employee of such category retiring before completion of the minimum requisite service of 10 years shall not be entitled to pension and he shall continue to be entitled to service gratuity as terms of E.I.E.R.S. O & A E I E R S Rules, 1981 and Rule 3 of O.A.E.I.E.R.S. (for Govt. fully aided primary school teachers) Retirement Benefit Rules, 1981 respectively.

2.2. Qualifying service of 10 years was required for sanction of full pension in terms of O & A E I E R S - Rule 1981 and O & A E I E R S (for Govt. fully Aided Primary School Teachers) Retirement Benefit Rules, 1981. Now the Govt. have been pleased to decide that such categories of employees as indicated under para 2.1 above who have retired on or after 01-12-06 and have rendered the minimum qualifying service of 25 years should now be entitled for sanction at the rate of 50% of the last established basic pay + grade pay drawn by them on the date of their retirement. Rule 4(2) (a) and 8(2) (b) of the O & A E I E R S Retirement benefit Rules, 1981 stands modified to the above effect.
