OFFICE MEMORANDUM

No. 8033 /SME, dated, the 19 th May, 2009

Sub:- V-SME-P-12/09 Sanction of D.A. to the employees of Aided Educational Institutions from 01.01.2006, 01.07.2006, 01.01.2007, 01.07.2007, 01.01.2008 and 01.07.2008 on the Revised Scale of Pay, 2008.

Finance Department, Government of Orissa, vide Resolution No.54080/PCC-51/2008 dated 16.12.2008 have revised the scale of Pay of the State Government employees and in their office Memorandum No.55808/CS-4-1/2008 dated 29.12.2008 have revised the rate of D.A. of Government Employees from 01.01.2006. In the meanwhile the scale of pay of the employees of the Aided Educational Institutions have been revised, vide S&ME Department Resolution No.6432/SME dated 13.04.2009 w.e.f. 01.01.2006. Government after careful consideration have decided that the rate of D.A. to the employees of Aided Educational Institutions shall be admissible from the dates mentioned in Table-I on the Pay and Grade Pay in the revised Pay structure.

TABLE -I

| 01.01.2006 | No D.A. is payable |
| 01.07.2006 | 2% of the Basic Pay plus Grade Pay |
| 01.01.2007 | 6% of the Basic Pay plus Grade Pay |
| 01.07.2007 | 9% of the Basic Pay plus Grade Pay |
| 01.01.2008 | 12% of the Basic Pay plus Grade Pay |
| 01.07.2008 | 16% of the Basic Pay plus Grade Pay |

Consequent on revision of the Scale of Pay w.e.f. 01.01.2006 followed by sanction of the revised dose of D.A. as indicated in Table-I, the Dearness Pay (DP) sanctioned, vide Office Memorandum No.18739/SME dated 20.09.2006 stands adjusted with the emoluments in the revised scale.

Payment of D.A. from the dates mentioned above shall be made after adjusting the installment of Dearness Allowance sanctioned and paid to the employees of the Aided Educational Institutions as indicated in Table-II.



The term 'Basic Pay' in the revised pay structure means the pay drawn in the prescribed pay band plus the applicable Grade Pay but does not include Special Pay etc.

D.A. on the revised pay is applicable to the employees of the Aided Educational Institutions who are covered under ORSP Rules, 2008 at the rate mentioned above in Table-I. However, D.A. at the rate circulated by School & Mass Education Department resolution No.13666 dtd.05.07.2008 will be admissible to other employees who are not covered under ORSP Rules, 2008.

D.A. in the revised Scales of pay shall apply only to those teaching and non-teaching staff who have been appointed in regular manner against the approved posts carrying the regular scales of pay in due observation of relevant rules of Aided Non-Government High Schools / Primary / Upper Primary Schools / Sanskrit Tolls / Senior and Junior Madrasas, who are in receipt of grants-in-aid from Government.

D.A. in accordance with this Memorandum will also be admissible to the employees of Aided Educational Institutions who were in service on 01.01.2006 but ceased to be in service at the time of sanction of DA as per Revised Scale of Pay.
