Sub: Sanction of additional dose of Dearness Allowance to the Teaching & non-Teaching staff of fully Aided Educational Institutions.

Finance Deptt. in their Office Memorandum No.22064/CS-IV-I/08 dt.21.4.09 have revised the rates of D.A. payable to the employees of State Govt. from 16% to 22% w.e.f.1.1.09 in the revised scale of pay.

After careful consideration, Govt. have been pleased to release additional dose of D.A. @ 6% raising the rate of D.A. from 16% to 22% on the pay and Grade Pay taken together w.e.f.1.1.09 to the employees of the Aided Educational Institutions whose pay has been revised w.e.f.1.1.06 as per S&ME Deptt. Resolution No.6432 dt.13.4.09.


D.A. at the rate circulated in S&ME Deptt. O.M. No.13666 dt.5.7.08 will be admissible to the employees of the Aided Educational Institutions whose pay has not been revised as per S&ME Deptt. Resolution No.6432 dtd.13.4.09.

D.A. in accordance with this Memorandum will also be admissible to the employees of the Aided Educational Institutions who were in service on the 1st day of January,2009 but have ceased to be in service at the time of sanction of this enhanced D.A.


The D.A. now payable will be drawn from the Pay Bill for April,2009 and onwards. Arrears from the month of January,2009 to March,2009 will be drawn and

disbursed latest by 28.2.2010 after regular Budget 2009-10 is passed by Orissa Legislative Assembly and getting clearance from Finance Deptt.

This issues as per instructions contained in Para-5 of Finance Deptt. Resolution No.22064 dt.21.4.09.


