OFFICE ORDER

The un-seasonal rain due to the effect of cyclonic depression have caused extensive damage to both paddy and non paddy crops. The farmers of 23 Districts namely Bargarh, Bolangir, Boudh, Deogarh, Dhenkanal, Gajapati, Ganjam, Jharsuguda, Kalahandi, Kandhamal, Keonjhar, Khurdha, Koraput, Malkangiri, Mayurbhanj, Nawarangpur, Nayagarh, Nuapada, Puri, Rayagada, Sambalpur, Subarnpur and Sundargarh have sustained crop loss of 50% and above in about 12 lakh hectares of crop area. **Hon'ble Chief Minister has announced a comprehensive package on the floor of the Assembly for the affected farmers to ameliorate the sufferings of the farmers.**

As per above special package, the School fees and school examination fees up to High School Level in Government/Govt. Aided Schools shall be waived in the affected areas for the year 2010-11.
